 - Pelvic, Prostate, Pap Smear, HVP, Colonoscopy, Testicular, or more.
- Hormone change
- Safe, healthy, and affirming sex (protection and resources)
- Contraception
- Gender affirming care

ADULTS (26-48)

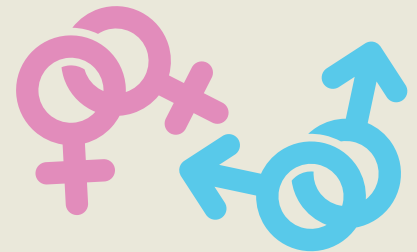
- Contraception

- Fertility services and preservation
- Child-free choice & planning
- Gender affirming care
- Postpartum care
- Safe, healthy, and affirming sex (protection and resources)
- Breastfeeding support (for all genders)
- Miscarriage after-care
- Screening exams
 - Ex) Pap smear
