Our Queer Rights Guide to Reproductive Health



The state of California has important laws intended to protect our reproductive freedoms. As **LGBTQ community members**, medical settings can sometimes feel intimidating — but rest assured our state aspires to guarantee access to our basic health care needs such as abortion, regardless of our sexual orientation or gender identity.

Whether you're a California resident or not, the law is clear about the rights a pregnant person has.

You have the right to a safe and legal abortion without the need to provide a reason for seeking an abortion.

Use the *California Abortion Finder* to find a provider that is right for you.

You have the right to access abortion services for little-to-no charge.

California mandates that insurance plans as well as Medi-Cal cover the cost of abortion services. If you have questions about your insurance you can contact the California Department of Insurance at (800) 927-4357.

You have the right to confidentiality.

An individual can obtain an abortion without having parents or spouses notified.

*Note: some exceptions do apply.

There are no residency requirements for seeking or obtaining an abortion in California.

Our state does not investigate, prosecute, incarcerate, or collaborate with other states to detain an individual who obtains or aids someone in obtaining an abortion.

You have the right to a timely abortion,

including medical prescription, urgent care, non-urgent care appointments.
