We believe in our people's rights and capacity to make informed and caring decisions about their reproductive health

Regardless of what generational group you are a part of, reproductive health impacts everyone in our community!

From navigating hormone changes, making important decisions about whether and how you want to have and raise children, or detecting and preventing cancer in reproductive organs—our program intends to uplift your queer rights, needs, and bodily autonomy.

Program Services:

- Focus Groups: invite us to your organization or community space to share the news about our program and conduct public surveys on how reproductive health impacts our daily lives.

The North County LGBTQ Resource Center has officially launched the Reproductive Justice Project, a program geared towards raising awareness, advocacy support, and accompaniment services for our LGBTQ+ community members in all reproductive health related matters. Starting Fall of 2024, clients can request one-on-one case management support and accompaniment as they navigate intimate medical processes such as an abortion. Additionally, community members are encouraged to seek our program for advocacy support should they face barriers that complicate or deter them from realizing their reproductive healthcare needs.
